getting started

Cocktail making is an art, and to create something beautiful, you need some basic equipment. Here are 9 essential tools for all you aspiring mixologists!

#1 Jigger

This hourglass shaped device is used to measure spirits accurately. Start with a double jigger with a 30ml and 15ml end.

#2 Shaker

The two most common are the Cobbler Cocktail Shaker and the Boston Shaker. The Boston shaker is the professional bartender's choice due to its large capacity, and ability to be easily cleaned making it more efficient. But a Cobbler shaker is perfectly fine too if you're just starting out.

#3 Strainer

With a Cobbler shaker, no need for a strainer, you're all set! However, with a Boston shaker you'll need a strainer. The common choice is the Hawthorne strainer, which is placed at the top of the glass or strainer to strain the drink.

#4 Pourers

Attach these to the top of your alcohol bottles to improve the accuracy of pouring. No guarantees on spills!

#5 Bar Spoon

Features a long and spiral handle that's perfect for stirring drinks. The spiral allows you to pour drinks along and create layered cocktails. Choose gold, silver, rose gold or black!

#6 Muddler

Similar to a mortar and pestle, a muddler is used to process fruits, herbs and spices in a way that simply releases the aromas without bruising it. If you don't want a separate item, the back of the bar spoon doubles as a muddler!

#7 Channel Knife

Make your cocktails look next level by using this small spoon-shaped knife to peel long, thin spirals from citrus fruits to make garnishes.

#8 Yarai Mixing Glass

This Japanese mixing glass is crafted with a heavier base and curved pour spout. A staple to make cocktails that are stirred not shaken.

#9 Glasses

You can never have too many glasses. There are Martini glasses, Collins glasses, Old Fashioned and Coupe glasses just to name a few. Start your collection today!

Plus, you'll need some other equipment that can easily be found in your kitchen such as a chopping board, fine sieve, knives, ice scoops and citrus juicer.

What are you waiting for? Get mixing! Try out some classics or invent your own!
